- 08 → ~~can~~ International / Inter-Governmental Organization.
- 09 → Founded in 1945 with the purpose to:-
- 10 → To maintain international peace and security.
 - 11 → To promote economic and social development
 - 11 → To promote Human Rights.
- 12 → Original Members - (51), Present Members - (193)
- 01 → India is founding member of the United Nations.
- 02 → India officially joined (ratified) UN on October 30, 1945.
- 03 → Recent most addition to UN - South Sudan - July 2011
- 04 → Headquarters - in New York.
- 05 → The name "United Nations" - coined by the then U.S. President - Franklin D. Roosevelt
- 06 → First used in the Declaration by United Nations of 1 January 1942, during second world war.
- 07 → Original UN logo - created by a team of designers in 1945 - led by Oliver Lincoln Lundquist
- Initially (in 1946), General Assembly established Chinese, French, English, Russian and Spanish as
