

Corporate Legal FrameworkTopic - Incorporation or Registration of Companies

The first stage of legal aspects of company formation is incorporation or registration of company. Under this after performing certain initial activities documents are to be submitted in the office of Registrar. After this certificate of incorporation is received after depositing a certain fee. A company comes into existence only after incorporation. Till the time, company is not incorporated, it cannot be said a company from legal point of view. According to Section 7 of the Companies Act 2013, following are the provisions regarding the incorporation of a company -

1. Filing of Documents etc - The following documents and informations shall be filed with the Registrar with in whose jurisdiction the registered office of a company is proposed to be situated, for registration -
 - a) Memorandum of Association - It is a very important document. No company can be incorporated without memorandum of association. It defines objectives of company under
